The Gibson bus service will operate for medical appointments only. Schedule with the Gibson office as usual.

Meals on Wheels will still be operating. We have experienced some volunteer attrition, so you may get two meals in one day. Your driver may be wearing a safety mask and gloves, but this is to protect both of you.

Congregate Meals. The dining room at the Center in North Conway will be closed! However, we will have "to go" meals (delicious as ever) that may be picked up at the Center during normal dining hours of 11:30-12:15 Monday through Friday. There will be NO congregate meals at Silver Lake Landing in Madison on Tuesdays.

The Gibson staff will be working throughout this time, but there is no public access to the building.

We are in the same boat as many of you. **BUT MEALS WILL GO OUT AND WE'LL GET YOU TO THE DOCTOR,** barring any new information.
