**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$54,443 to be added to the Expendable Trust Fund (New Kennett High School Facilities Maintenance Fund) established for that purpose in 2007, with \$35,546 to offset this amount from the sending towns and the remainder to be raised by general taxation. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 5-1-1) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 10-4-1) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 3.** To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$17,086 to be added to the Expendable Trust Fund (A. Crosby Kennett Middle School Facilities Maintenance Fund) established for that purpose in 2007, with \$7,345 to offset this amount from the sending towns and the remainder to be raised by general taxation. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 5-1-1) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 11-4-0) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 5.** To see if the school district will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Conway School Board and the Conway Educational Support Personnel which calls for the following increase in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

2019-20	\$37,363
2020-21	\$81,375
2021-22	\$82,912

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$37,363 for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 12-2-1) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 6.** To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$38,328,279. (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 8-7-0) Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$38,129,959, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Conway School District or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (\$38,328,279 is recommended by the School Board 6-1-0)

**ARTICLE 7.** To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$33,948 to supplement the funding of the John H. Fuller School, Conway Elementary School, and Pine Tree School Project SUCCEED Programs. (Designated as a Special Article) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 13-2-0) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 8.** To see if the school district will vote to establish an Equipment and/or School Buses Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for the purpose of purchasing equipment and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250,000 to be placed in this fund. Further, to name the school board as agents to expend from said fund. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 11-3-1) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 9.** To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$219,000 for the purpose of purchasing two school buses and a one-ton dump truck. (Designated as a Special Article) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 13-2-0) This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article #6, the operating budget.
